Summer Results

We are extremely excited to formally announce our first set of results at BOA Stage and Screen Production Academy. A truly exceptional first year!

- √ 100% of students passing their qualification
- ✓ 99% of students achieved high grades ('Distinction, Distinction, Distinction' or better)
- √ 81% achieved the top possible grade combination of 'Distinction*, Distinction*, Distinction*' in their chosen pathway.
- ✓ 50% are going to University, 25% to Apprenticeships and 25% direct into Employment/Freelancing
- ✓ 91% of students who studied an additional A'level option subject or equivalent achieved a grade C or above.

Timetables

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Induction 2023

<u>Year 12</u>: We have an exciting induction programme planned for our new incoming year 12 students. Over a two week period, students will take part in a range of creative pathway projects. Students will work from client briefs to develop short films, props, costumes, and lightshows that will be showcased and celebrated in an exhibition at the end of the two-week induction programme. Alongside these, we will be holding an exclusive industry panel. This will give students the opportunity to meet and hear from a number of stage and screen industry professionals. We have organised a variety of excellent educational trips. The *Broadcast*, *Film & Content Creation*, and *Writing*, *Directing and Screen-craft* pathways will visit Warner Bros Studios - The Making of Harry Potter where they will take part in a 'Miseen-scene' workshop followed by a studio tour. The *Production Arts & Stage Management*, and *Technical Theatre & Live Events* pathways will visit the National Theatre where they will take part in a backstage tour and attend the V&A exhibition. <u>Year 13:</u> Induction will run over one week period and will focus on personal progression and next steps. We will be holding an industry panel with screen and stage professionals named 'Breaking into the Stage and Screen Industry'. Students will take part in a range of informative seminars and workshops lead by Alison Grade, Author of the Freelance Bible. These sessions will focus on personal finance, self-promotion and networking. Students will complete job applications and interview preparation for roles on a variety of major collaborative projects that take place from September through to December. Some of our major projects include Peter Pan the Musical which will take place at the Old Rep Theatre and a major one-shot film feature project with Threewise Entertainment.
